INSTRUCTIONS

When one of the parents or guardian is not available to sign the Statement of Intent (Band Division) on behalf of a child, the Statement in Lieu of a Parent's Signature must be completed and signed in front of a person authorized by law to administer an oath or solemn affirmation (for example, a Justice of the Peace, lawyer or Notary Public. Alternatively, written confirmation by a social worker or an Indian registration administrator (IRA) may be provided. The statement must include:

- why it was not possible to obtain the parent's signature;
- the efforts made to obtain information on the whereabouts of the parent;
- the parent's last known address and telephone number, and the approximate date he/she was last known to be at that location; and
- the last time (approximate date) the parent exercised his/her access rights.
